I am pleased to inform you that the Technical MA Framework for the PDA Childhood Practice (Level 9) has been approved by the Modern Apprentice Group (MAG). In line with Scottish Government's priority skills policy the Modern Apprenticeship Group (MAG) identified that the Framework would initially be available for 20-24 year olds.

The SSSC is currently in negotiations with Scottish Government about this as it is the view of employers in the sector that over 24s comprise the main group that would require skills development funding under this framework. I will provide you with additional information when colleagues in the Scottish Governments Employability, Skills and Lifelong Learning Directorate respond to our request.
