• The SSSC is established in October 2001 under the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001

2002



• In March 2002, the SSSC HQ opens in Dundee
• In September 2002, we published our first Code of Practice

2003



• In April 2003, our Register opens for the first time
• The framework for Social Work Education in Scotland published

2004



• In June 2004, we held our first Care Accolades Awards ceremony
• The Register opens to social work students and Care Inspectorate inspectors (previously Care Commission officers)
• Launch of our first digital learning website
• First social work honours and postgraduate degrees introduced

2005



• First compulsory date of registration for social workers
• Register opens for managers and supervisors in residential childcare services
• Qualification set for housing support and care at home workers

2006



• First conduct and registration hearings
• Register opens to all residential childcare workers, managers of adult day care services, managers of care home services for adults and managers of day care of children services

2007



• Publish the Standard for Childhood Practice
• Register opens for practitioners in day care of children services and supervisors in care home services for adults

2008



• By 2008 we'd held over 30 hearings including Registration Sub Committee (RSC) hearings and Conduct Sub Committee (CSC) hearings

2009



• Register opens for managers of residential childcare accommodation
• Compulsory registration for residential childcare workers, managers of care home services for adults and adult day care services

2010



• Host our 2010 conference, 20:20 vision – the social service workforce fit for the future
• Compulsory registration for managers and lead practitioners in day care of children services

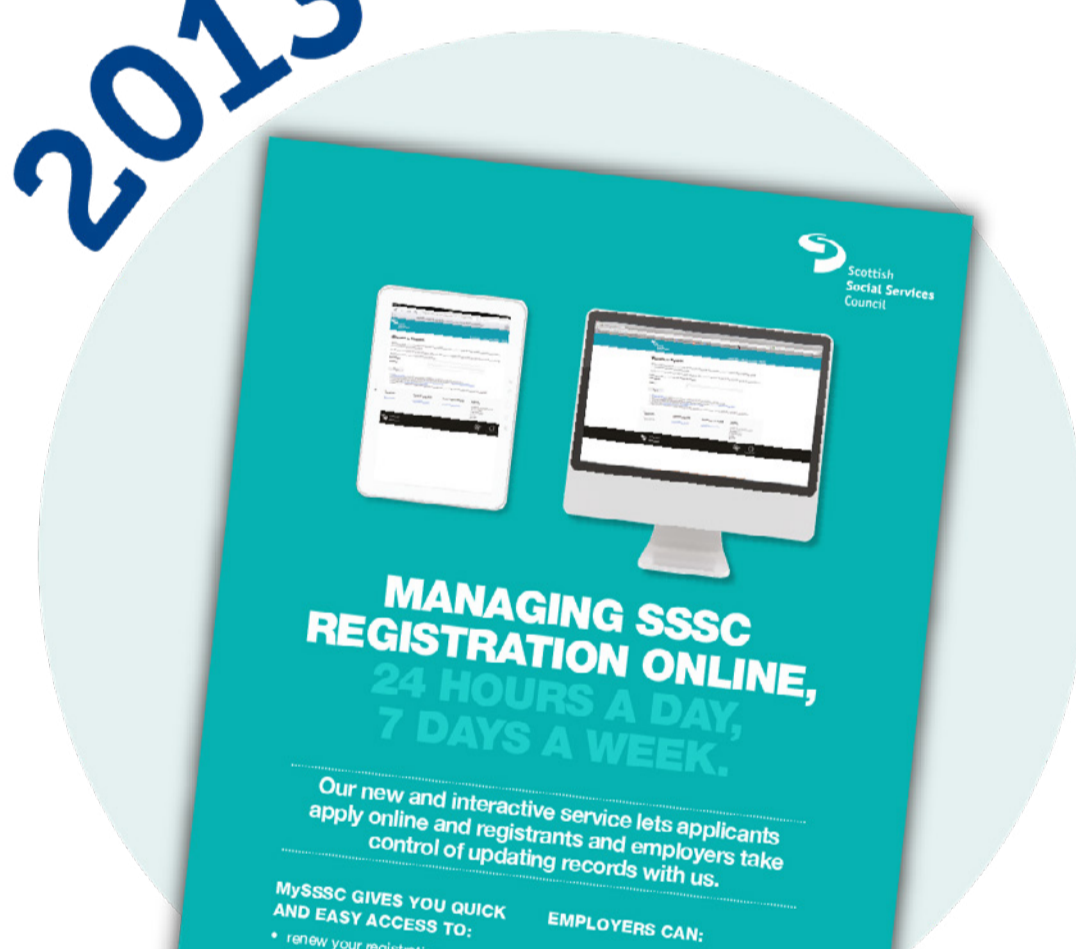


• Publish Promoting Excellence, a learning framework for working with people with dementia
