We accept a combination of the following units as meeting the supervisory requirement for supervisors in care at home, housing support and care home services for adults.

We do not accept other units from these qualifications that are not on the list.

We have highlighted in blue those units we have identified as most closely matching the skills, knowledge and values needed for effective supervision.

You should discuss with your employer and training provider which would be the best units to develop your supervision skills, match with your current job role and support your career development.

We have listed the SQA unit code, the Sector Skills Council (SSC) code, the title, the SCQF level and the SCQF credit for each unit. We have also noted which are mandatory (M) and which are optional (O) within the qualifications.
